Secretary's Meeting Minutes

AVQA Board Meeting January 20, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 6:39 by President Carolyn Lundie.

Present at the meeting Gay Goddard, Kathy Greene, Jamie Harrington, Pat Stauning, Kathy Judkins, Edie Jones, Rosie Cuevas, Sandy Smith, Coral Brown, Dixie Bahr, Lynell Rodio and Maralyne Ullerich.

President's Report: Since Carolyn filled in for Gay while Gay was gone, she got a taste of what is involved in transporting all the irons and ironing boards to the Toyota building. Carolyn stated that we need iron caddies so they are easier to transport to class. Discussion included using ironing pads and tabletop ironing boards instead of standard ironing boards to avoid carrying heavy ironing boards upstairs. Using a dolly was also discussed. Dixie volunteered to loan a dolly to see if this would work before any purchase is made. Ironing pads and table top boards will be tested at the next open sew to see how well it works. Kathy Greene is donating an iron to guild.

Patti Keene donated numerous baskets to the guild before she left and thought she gave them to Nani. If anyone knows where the baskets are, please let Carolyn know.

A microphone stand is needed for our speakers. Carolyn will be putting a request out on Facebook to members to see if anyone has one before we purchase a stand. The guild still needs an Opportunity Quilt Chair since Nani Johnson injured her kneecap and is unable to perform the job.

Carolyn requested the name of all Friendship Groups so that each group can take the Opportunity Quilt to a guild meeting. We also need a Friendship Group Chair. Orange County and North Cities Quilt Guilds requested to bring their Opportunity quilt to a guild meeting. We did say yes with the understanding that we could bring our Opportunity Quilt to their meetings. Looking for volunteers to bring quilt to meetings.

Jamie volunteered to bring the Opportunity quilt to the Tehachapi guild. Sandy Smith volunteered to bring the Opportunity quilt to the Bakersfield guild.

Motion made to approve the minutes of the board meeting by Edie Jones and 2nd by Coral Brown. Minutes approved.

<u>Treasurer</u> (Kathy Greene) – Treasurer gave a report of recent expenses and income. Our current balance is now \$23,374.99. Kathy is working with the Franchise Tax Board in getting our Raffle approval. Also, working with SCCQG for the insurance for retreats and the quilt show.

1st Vice President (Gay Goddard) – Thanked Carolyn for filling in for her while on vacation. Speaker David Taylor who was scheduled for next July has been canceled due to the cost. She has most of the next year scheduled with the exception of July 2015.

2nd Vice President (Jamie Harrington) - Had her first quilt show meeting Jan 13th. Has a new vendor, Sew Cranky who will also give a 45-minute lecture about sewing machines. She has 6 paid vendors presently. Looking for volunteers lead 'Make it and Take It' classes. Michelle Johnson did agree to redo our quilt show signs for recycle items, plastic bottles and cans. The funds are donated to the Highland Track team. There was a discussion on the quilt show entry paperwork for the April meeting.

Our Door Prize Chairs, Sydney Looper and Lynn Michaud will chair raffle Baskets at the Quilt show. Each Friendship Circle needs to make a basket and list all the items in the baskets.

The next quilt show meeting will be March 10th at Jamie's home.

Jamie spoke with Roxanne Flint who is working with Homestead to set up an e-mail address for AVQA.

<u>Publicity</u> (Kathy Judkins) - Had 200 flyers printed and sent to SCCQG. Some of them have been returned since there was not a representative from all the guilds at the SCCQG meeting. Flyers were sent to Road to California with Michelle Johnson. Pat Stauning will check on the flyers each day and bring back any extras. Members can

get flyers from Kathy to be placed at different venues around the Antelope Valley. Corinne Gurney took some to Candy's Quilt store.

Ridgecrest Quilt Show is March 14-15. Need a volunteer to bring the Opportunity Quilt to the show. Sue Jacobsen donated \$100 for the Opportunity Quilt.

Membership (Dixie Bahr) - We now have 110 members, which is just slightly less than last year at this time. Membership rosters and updates are available at the membership table as you come in.

<u>Parliamentarian</u> (Edie Jones) - Has a box of cards for our Sunshine chair Janice Zark.

Opportunity Quilt 2016 (Gay & Jamie) - Jamie presented some blocks she made for the quilt. Discussion on the funds needed to purchase fabric for the quilt using only batiks.

There was a discussion on the Mardi Bra activity (which can be looked up on line.) We are asking that each member bring in some feminine hygiene products to donate to shelters. If you bring a donation you will receive an extra ticket for a prize from the membership table.

The group has also given out 36 Bereavement quilts to mothers who have lost their babies. Lynell has set up an office space with 6 tables at her husband's work place. Everything you need to sew is there. Just bring your machines. Call Lynell and make arrangements.

<u>Veterans</u> (Betty Putzka) Betty stated that quilts were given to veterans on most Tuesday's at Crazy Otto's.
