The **Happy Place** quilt challenge is due at the **May 8th** AVQA meeting and you have a whole month to finish your entry. I am looking forward to seeing all that you have done. Here are a few final details.

1. Please be sure your name is on the back of your quilt. It doesn't need to be a fancy label, just something to identify you as the maker. Your quilt will be assigned a number for the Viewer's Choice selection process and your name will not be visible.

2. Please arrive early to the meeting and bring your quilt concealed in a bag. Bring it to me in the back of the room. I will display the quilts on a table for viewing.

3. After the "judging" has taken place, you will pick up your quilt and we will do a show and share of these quilts. Please tell a little bit about what your happy place is and discuss any techniques you used to make the quilt. Please limit your talk to about 2 minutes.

4. When the show and share of the challenge quilts is completed, I will announce the winner. There is a very nice prize.

There is still time for you to finish your quilt. If you are struggling, try to simplify your design. If you set aside just an hour a day, 5 days a week until the meeting it should be doable. I would love to have this challenge be a success for all of you.
